Believe God's promise to forgive (Isaiah 43:25) Be joyful in forgiveness and new life (2 Cor 5:17) Don't keep dwelling on the past (1 John 1:9) 2 Samuel 12
David has sinned
against Bathsheba,
Uriah, Joab, but
when Nathan
confronts him, he
repents (Psalm 51)

1 Samuel 25
Nabal insults David and threatens him and his men. David tells his men to take revenge with swords.

Bucket #3

You were sinned against You responded sinfully

Did you get even? Rom 12:14-21 Did you get bitter? (Ruth 1:20-21 and Eph 4) Did you confront? (Matt 18:15) Did you forgive? (Eph 4:32)

Bucket #4

You sinned
You responded sinfully

Contemplate and confess your sin (Prov 28:13, Psalm 32:5)
Make things right with others (Numbers 5:6-7)
Put on the fruit of repentance (Gal 5:22-23)

2 Samuel 11
David commits
adultery and further
sins by tricking
Uriah into drinking
and then has Joab
send him to the
frontlines to be
killed.
